The Survey

- Not At All, Sometimes, Most of the Time, Definitely, Not Sure
- Option to add additional comment
- Completed by Pupils in P4-7
- Issued to all parents - 16 completed



Analysis of pupil returns

- Majority of the children answered 'Most of the Time' or 'Definitely'

Points of note:

- seeking help when needed
- knowing what to do if worried about self or others
- feeling recognised as an individual
- views being listened to and leading to change
- giving up when things are difficult



Analysis of parent returns

Points of note:

- giving up when things are difficult
- issues with homework
- consistency across different classes
- looking for a wider range of after school activities
- celebrating a wider range of achievements
